Dear Homeowner,

At the National Night Out event, Hays County Emergency Services informed us that locating a house in our neighborhood is difficult because our neighborhood does not have mailboxes or a standard street number location. They also made us aware of a county sponsored program that offers reduced cost reflective address markers. In response, the Homeowners Association has purchased reflective address markers from Hays County for each lot in the neighborhood.

Your address numbers should be posted and visible from the road so that emergency service agencies can easily find you in case of an emergency.

Please follow these mounting instructions when posting your address number:

1. Sign should NOT be mounted on mailbox as mailboxes are not always located adjacent to the driveway to your property
2. Sign may be mounted on either side of driveway entrance
3. Mounting should be one to two feet high
4. Sign should be visible from public roadway
5. Make sure no weeds or any other items block view of sign
6. If you live on a through street, mount the two signs back-to-back so that the number is visible from both directions

In addition to posting an address number sign, it is suggested that you write your address in large print on or near your phone.

We hope that you will mount the address marker to assist emergency crews in finding your home.
